IDA Governance Committee Meeting January 8, 2025

Legislative Update

The Governor vetoed legislation that would require representatives from school boards and unions to serve on IDA boards. Legislation was approved that IDAs consider the extent to which a project would provide onsite daycare at their facility. The Agency will comply with this law change.

Housing Study

Two proposals for the housing study have been received. Ms. Scheidt made a motion to recommend the proposal from Camoin Associates at a cost of \$24,000 to the full Board. The motion was seconded by Mr. Rose and unanimously approved. Camoin estimates it will take approximately three months to complete.
