9	resolution for the Framerica Corporation.
10	It's an authorizing resolution. We had a
11	public hearing yesterday.
12	To remind everyone, this is you saw
13	this project at our last meeting. They are
14	requesting to lease the remaining space of the
15	19 Nicholas facility for their warehousing and
16	distribution use. They make moldings for
17	frames and like the segues between rooms and
18	this falls under our leased building policy.
19	There was no comment at the public hearing.
20	It's a final authorizing resolution and the
21	PILOT and the cost benefit analysis is
22	included in your packets.
23	Did anyone have any questions?
24	MR. BRAUN: As we mentioned in past
25	meetings, this is a long time, a very good

- request that we received from United Rentals.

2	This is a project that's been under
3	construction for a while now. They they're
4	almost done, but they have a few last pieces
5	and what they asked for was an extension of
6	their completion date and also to push out
7	their job creation numbers until May 31, 2021.
8	We extended it once from November 30,
9	2020 to March 31, 2021, but they think they're
10	going to need a little more time, they don't .
11	I think it's mostly COVID, that's at least
12	what their letter explains.
13	I have the authority to push this out,
14	but I just figured since we're having a
15	meeting, I'd bring it to you.
16	Howard, did you want to add anything?
17	MR. GROSS: Actually I didn't realize,
18	I apologize, that they were looking to push
19	out their employment figures as well.
20	MS. MULLIGAN: Well, actually I assume
21	that we have to because if they're not going
22	to be in, are they going to have time or
23	MR. GROSS: So my suggestion is that if
2 4	the board is so of that mindset, that they
25	should allow that to happen, you know, approve

2	that and if they need it, we can give it to
3	them and we'll amend the lease accordingly
4	because I don't think you have authority on
5	your own to do, I think a completion date you
6	do.
7	MS. MULLIGAN: Right, okay.
8	MR. BRAUN: Then we need a motion to
9	that effect.
L 0	MR. GRUCCI: So moved.
1	MR. BRAUN: Felix.

4	MR. BRAUN: Well, hiatus or terminal,
15	they're two different terms?
L 6	MR. GRUCCI: Well, is it terminal
L 7	first?
18	MR. BRAUN: I don't think so. I think
_9	we just need to get a better handle on what
20	it's costing us to absorb all of the monies
21	that previously were paid by the Town. I mean
22	we know what the salaries are. There are
23	still some other benefit numbers that we don't
2.4	have yet and need to talk to some consultants
2.5	about, so I wouldn't say it was terminal:

2	hiatus, yes.
3	MR. GRUCCI: Okay.
4	MR. TROTTA: Do you have any idea,
5	Fred, the time frame?
6	MR. BRAUN: I would guess May, June.
7	MR. TROTTA: Okay.
8	MR. BRAUN: If we have anything before
9	that we can talk about it, but it may take a
10	little while for us to get the right
11	consultants to talk to us about some of the
12	benefit programs.
13	MS. MULLIGAN: We need to we're
14	working on our audit and PARIS right now,
15	focused on those two items and then I think
16	what we need next steps are probably to get an
17	HR firm to come in, clean up our policies,
18	make sure that we're all presentable and then
19	we're going to need an actuarial firm to come
20	in and provide us with next steps, which will
21	lead us to some of those dollar amounts and
22	give us some
23	MR. CALLAHAN: Guidance.
2 4	MS. MULLIGAN: Focus on that.
25	MR. BRAUN: Actually there are two

1 2 audits we're worried about, not worried about, but we've got our financial audit and we also have the audit from the comptroller's office 4 of the LDC, so --5 6 MS. MULLIGAN: Three if you think about 7 it that way --8 MR. BRAUN: And PARIS. 9 MS. MULLIGAN: -- because there's the 10 LDC audit, the IDA audit and then there's the OSC LDC audit, so three audits. 11 12 MR. BRAUN: Plus PARIS. 13 MS. MULLIGAN: Plus two PARIS. 14 MR. BRAUN: We will always have PARIS. 15 MS. MULLIGAN: Pilot used to fly you to 16 Paris, now not the same meaning to me anymore. 17 MR. TULLO: Definitely not. 18 MR. BRAUN: Anything else? 19 (No response.) 20 MR. BRAUN: Hearing none, I'll take a 21 motion to adjourn.
