Chairman Braun opened the Industrial Development Agency Audit Committee meeting at 12:22 P.M. on Wednesday, March 29, 2023, in the Agency's Office on the Second Floor of Brookhaven Town Hall, One Independence Hill, Farmingville, New York. A quorum was present.

AUDIT PRESENTATION

Mr. Davoli provided a brief presentation on the audit for 2022 to the Board. Revenue and expenses were both lower than the prior year and interest income increased. Owing to a new accounting pronouncement, the impact of the lease with the Town appears both as an asset and a corresponding liability on the balance sheet. The Other Post Employee Benefits costs decreased due to an increase in the discount rate. A clean opinion has been issued, and the Agency was found to be in compliance with generally accepted auditing standards.
