3 American Regent Inc., a business corporation organized and existing under the 4 5 laws of the State of New York, on behalf of 6 itself and or the principals of American 7 Regent Inc. and/or an entity formed or to be 8 formed on behalf of any of the foregoing (the 9 "Company"), has applied to the Agency to enter 10 into a transaction in which the Agency will 11 assist the Company in the acquisition of a 12 leasehold interest in an approximately 30.2748-acre parcel of land located at 5 13 14 Ramsey Road Drive, Shirley, Town of 15 Brookhaven, New York (further identified as 16 Tax Map Nos. District 0200, Section 584.00, 17 Block 01.00, Lot 004.003, 004.005, 4.039 and 18 4.443) (the "Land"), upon which there are two 19 (2) existing 2-story buildings. The Company 20 has requested the Agency's assistance in 21 connection with the construction and equipping 22 of an approximately 14,104 square foot 23 expansion to one of the existing approximately 24 94,876 square foot manufacturing buildings 25 with accessory office space ("Building One"),

the renovations of approximately 37,650 square 2 3 feet of space in Building One (the "Improvements") and the acquisition and 4 5 installation of equipment, including, but not 6 limited to, the acquisition of process and 7 manufacturing isolated fill lines and the 8 accompanying office and laboratory space to 9 support such lines (collectively, the 10 "Equipment"; and with the Land and Improvements, the "Facility"), all to be 11 12 leased by the Agency to the Company, and used 13 by the Company for the development, manufacturing and warehousing of generic drugs 14 (the "Project"). The Facility will be 15 16 initially owned and managed or operated by the 17 Company.

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18 The Agency contemplates that it will 19 provide financial assistance to the Company in 20 the form of exemptions from mortgage recording 21 taxes in connection with the financing or any subsequent refinancing or permanent financing 22 23 of the Facility, exemptions from sales and use 24 taxes in connection with the construction and 25 equipping of the Facility, and abatement of

2 real property taxes, all consistent with the 3 uniform tax exemption policies ("UTEP") of the 4 Agency.

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5 A representative of the Agency will, at 6 the above-stated time and place, hear and 7 accept written comments from all persons with 8 views in favor of or opposed to either the 9 proposed financial assistance to the Company 10 or the location or nature of the Facility. 11 Prior to the hearing, all persons will have 12 the opportunity to review on the Agency's 13 website (https://brookhavenida.org/), the 14 application for financial assistance filed by 15 the Company with the Agency and an analysis of 16 the costs and benefits of the proposed 17 Facility.
