Members of the public may

listen to the Public Hearing, and comment on the Project (defined below) and the benefits to be granted by the Agency to the Company (defined below) during the Public Hearing, by calling 712-770-5505 and entering access code 884-124. Comments maybe also submitted to the Agency in writing or electronically. Minutes of the Public Hearing will be transcribed and posted on the Agency's website, all in connection with the following matters:

Holtsville Solar, LLC, a Delaware limited liability company, on behalf of itself and/or the principals of Holtsville Solar, LLC, and the equity investors in and any tax credit investors in Holtsville Solar, LLC and/or an entity formed or to be formed on behalf of any of the foregoing (collectively, the "Company"), has applied to the Agency, to enter into a transaction in which the Agency will assist in the acquisition of a long term ground leasehold interest in an approximately 27.13-acre parcel of land located at 249 Buckley Road, Holtsville, New York 11742 (more particularly described as Suffolk County Tax

2	Map No. $0200-891.00-03.00-020.000$) (the
3	"Land"), owned by the Town of Brookhaven (the
4	"Town"), the construction of an approximately
5	1,428 kW DC solar carport array thereon (the
6	"Improvements"), and the acquisition and
7	installation of certain equipment and personal
8	property therein including, but not limited
9	to, approximately 3,570 400 W solar modules,
10	inverters, and electrical equipment (the
11	"Equipment"; and together with the Land and
12	the Improvements, the "Facility"), which
13	Facility will be sub-subleased, subleased and
14	leased by the Agency to the Company and used
15	by the Company as a solar power generating
16	facility, which is expected to produce
17	approximately 1.79 million kW-hours of clean
18	electrical energy per year for the benefit of
19	the Town (collectively the "Project"). The
20	Facility will be initially owned, operated
21	and/or managed by the Company.
22	The Agency will acquire a subleasehold

interest in the Land, a leasehold interest in the Improvements and title to or a leasehold interest in therest in the Equipment and will

sub-sublease, sublease and lease the Facility
to the Company. The Agency contemplates that
it will provide financial assistance to the
Company in the form of exemptions from
mortgage recording taxes in connection with
the financing or any subsequent refinancing of
the Facility, exemptions from sales and use
taxes and abatement of real property taxes,
consistent with the policies of the Agency.

A representative of the Agency will, at the above-stated time and place, hear and accept written comments from all persons with views in favor of or opposed to either the proposed financial assistance to the Company or the location or nature of the Facility. Prior to the hearing, all persons will have the opportunity to review on the Agency's website (https://brookhavenida.org/), the application for financial assistance filed by the Company with the Agency and an analysis of the costs and benefits of the proposed Facility.
