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1 2 MS. MULLIGAN: This is the public hearing for BRP Farmingville LLC. I'm going 3 to read the public hearing notice for the 4 5 record. Because of the Novel Coronavirus -- is 6 7 there anybody else on with us? 8 (No response.) 9 MS. MULLIGAN: Hello? 10 (No response.) 11 MS. MULLIGAN: Did someone just join? 12 MS. LINSE: I heard something. 13 MS. MULLIGAN: Yeah, me, too. But I'm 14 going to read the public hearing notice for 15 BRP Farmingville LLC for the record. 16 Because of the Novel Coronavirus 17 (COVID-19) -- did someone just join? MS. LINSE: It sounds like it. 18 19 MR. WEIR: Yes, William Weir, counsel 20 to the IDA joined. I was on earlier, but you 21 started talking and I disconnected you when I tried to take you off mute, so I'll put you 22 23 back on mute. 24 MS. MULLIGAN: Okay. I'm going to read 25 the public hearing notice.

2 Because of the Novel Coronavirus 3 (COVID-19) Emergency State and Federal bans on large meetings or gatherings and pursuant to 4 5 Governor Cuomo's Executive Order 220.1 issued 6 on March 12, 2020 suspending the Open Meetings 7 Law, the Public Hearing scheduled for 8 March 24, 2020 being held by the Town of 9 Brookhaven Industrial Development Agency (the 10 "Agency") in accordance with the provisions of Article 18-A of the New York General Municipal 11 12 Law with respect to BRP Farmingville LLC and 13 Brookhaven Venture LLC (the "Applicant") 14 regarding The Arboretum at Farmingville (the 15 "Project") will be held electronically via 16 conference call instead of a public hearing 17 open for the public to attend. Members of the public may listen to the Public Hearing and 18 19 comment on the Project and the benefits 20 granted to the Applicant by the Agency during 21 the Public Hearing by calling (712)770-5505 and entering access code 884-124. Comments 22 23 may also be submitted to the Agency in writing 24 or electronically. Minutes of the Public 25 Hearing will be transcribed and posted on the

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2 Agency's website. REVISED NOTICE OF SUPPLEMENTAL PUBLIC 3 HEARING. 4 5 NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a 6 supplemental public hearing pursuant to Title 7 1 of Article 18-A of the New York State 8 General Municipal Law will be held by the Town 9 of Brookhaven Industrial Development Agency 10 ("the Agency") on the 24th day of March, 2020, 11 at 10:00 a.m., local time, electronically by 12 calling (712)770-5505 and entering access code 884-124, in connection with the following 13 14 matters: 15 BRP Farmingville LLC, a limited 16 liability company organized and existing under 17 the laws of the State of New York, on behalf 18 of itself and/or the principals of BRP 19 Farmingville LLC and/or an entity formed or to 20 be formed on behalf of any of the foregoing 21 (collectively, "BRP"), submitted its application (the "Application") to the Agency 22 23 for assistance in connection with (A) the acquisition of an approximately 62.0 acre 24 25 parcel of land located at 510 Horseblock Road,

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Farmingville, New York (also known as 3 Tax 2 3 Map Nos. 0200-626.00-03.00-039.500 and 040.000 and 0200-653.00-07.00-001.000) (collectively, 4 5 the "Land"), (B)(i) the demolition of an 6 approximately 5,000 square foot building 7 located thereon, (ii) the renovation and 8 equipping of an approximately 3,000 square 9 foot building located thereon, and (iii) the 10 construction, equipping and furnishing of 11 multiple buildings to include 292 residential 12 units (of which 10% will be set aside as affordable units) and consisting of 164 13 14 two-bedroom units, (with 2 baths), 77 two and 15 three bedroom townhome style units (with 2 and 16 2.5 baths) and 51 single-family detached style 17 cottages which will be three and/or four 18 bedroom homes (with 2 and 2.5 bath), including 19 an approximately 7,500 square foot clubhouse, 20 with pools and outdoor activities, a state of 21 the art 150,000 gallons-per-day on-site waste water treatment plant, a 7-acre park with 22 23 walking trails for use by all residents of 24 Farmingville, and an approximately 1,200 25 square foot building to be constructed and

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donated for use by the Farmingville Chamber of 2 Commerce as an office, together with the 3 acquisition, installation and equipping of 4 5 improvements, structures and other related 6 facilities attached to the Land (the 7 "Improvements"), and (C) the acquisition and 8 installation therein of certain equipment and 9 personal property including, but not limited 10 to, including common areas consisting of recreational areas and other amenities and the 11 12 furnishing thereof including, but not limited 13 to furniture, appliances in the units, kitchen 14 equipment (the "Equipment"; and, together with 15 the Land and the Improvements, the 16 "Facility"), which Facility is to be subleased 17 by the Agency to BRP to be known as The Arboretum at Farmingville and used by BRP to 18 19 provide multi-family housing and outdoor 20 recreational green space areas for the 21 residents of Farmingville (the "Project"). The Agency previously held a public 22 23 hearing on August 20, 2019. 24 Subsequent to the submission of the 25 Application by BRP to the Agency, BRP notified

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the Agency of a change in ownership structure 2 3 of the Facility and requested that the Agency consent to amend the Application to reflect 4 5 that Brookhaven Venture LLC, a limited 6 liability company organized and existing under 7 the laws of the State of New York, on behalf 8 of itself and/or the principals of Brookhaven 9 Venture LLC and/or an entity formed or to be 10 formed on behalf of any of the foregoing (the "Company"), will be the fee owner of the 11 12 Project. The Facility will now be initially 13 owned, operated and/or managed by the Company and BRP. 14

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15 The Agency contemplates that it will 16 provide financial assistance to the Company in 17 the form of exemptions from mortgage recording 18 taxes in connection with the financing or any 19 subsequent refinancing of the Facility, 20 exemptions from sales and use taxes in 21 connection with the construction and equipping 22 of the Facility and exemption of real property 23 taxes consistent with the policies of the 24 Agency.

A representative of the Agency will, at

2 the above-stated time and place, hear and 3 accept written comments from all persons with views in favor of or opposed to either the 4 5 proposed financial assistance to the Company 6 or the location or nature of the Facility.
