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9 NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that due to the 10 Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19) Emergency State 11 and Federal bans on large meetings or 12 gatherings and pursuant to Governor Cuomo's Executive Order 202.1 issued on March 12, 13 14 2020, as amended to date, permitting local 15 governments to hold public hearings by 16 telephone and video conference and/or similar 17 device, the Public Hearing scheduled for February 9, 2021, at 11:30 a.m., local time, 18 19 being held by the Town of Brookhaven 20 Industrial Development Agency (the "Agency"), 21 in accordance with the provisions of Article 18-A of the New York General Municipal 22 23 Law will be held electronically via conference 24 call instead of a public hearing open for the 25 public to attend. Members of the public may

listen to the Public Hearing, and comment on 2 3 the Project (defined below) and the benefits to be granted by the Agency to the Company 4 5 (defined below) during the Public Hearing, by 6 calling 712-770-5505 and entering access code 884-124. Comments maybe also submitted to the 7 8 Agency in writing or electronically. Minutes 9 of the Public Hearing will be transcribed and 10 posted on the Agency's website, all in 11 connection with the following matters:

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12 Mastic Beach Solar, LLC, a Delaware 13 limited liability company, on behalf of itself 14 and/or the principals of Mastic Beach Solar, 15 LLC, and the equity investors in and any tax 16 credit investors in Mastic Beach Solar, LLC 17 and/or an entity formed or to be formed on behalf of any of the foregoing (collectively, 18 19 the "Company"), has applied to the Agency, to 20 enter into a transaction in which the Agency 21 will assist in the acquisition of a long term ground leasehold interest in an approximately 22 23 24.5-acre parcel of land located at 300 Mastic 24 Beach Road, Mastic Beach, New York 11951 (more 25 particularly described as Suffolk County Tax

2 Map No. 0200-938.00-05.00-023.001) (the 3 "Land"), owned by the Town of Brookhaven (the "Town"), the construction of an approximately 4 5 942 kW DC solar carport and rooftop array 6 thereon (the "Improvements"), and the 7 acquisition and installation of certain 8 equipment and personal property therein 9 including, but not limited to, approximately 10 2,354 400 W solar modules, inverters, and 11 electrical equipment (the "Equipment"; and 12 together with the Land and the Improvements, the **"Facility"**), which Facility will be 13 14 sub-subleased, subleased and leased by the 15 Agency to the Company and used by the Company 16 as a solar power generating facility, which is 17 expected to produce approximately 1.15 million 18 kW-hours of clean electrical energy per year 19 for the benefit of the Town (collectively, the 20 "Project"). The Facility will be initially 21 owned, operated and/or managed by the Company. The Agency will acquire a subleasehold 22

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interest in the Land, a leasehold interest in the Improvements and title to or a leasehold interest in the Equipment and will

2 sub-sublease, sublease and lease the Facility to the Company. The Agency contemplates that 3 it will provide financial assistance to the 4 5 Company in the form of exemptions from 6 mortgage recording taxes in connection with 7 the financing or any subsequent refinancing of 8 the Facility, exemptions from sales and use 9 taxes and abatement of real property taxes, 10 consistent with the policies of the Agency.

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11 A representative of the Agency will, at 12 the above-stated time and place, hear and 13 accept written comments from all persons with 14 views in favor of or opposed to either the 15 proposed financial assistance to the Company 16 or the location or nature of the Facility. 17 Prior to the hearing, all persons will have the opportunity to review on the Agency's 18 19 website (https://brookhavenida.org/), the 20 application for financial assistance filed by 21 the Company with the Agency and an analysis of 22 the costs and benefits of the proposed 23 Facility.
