10	MS. MULLIGAN: This is the Town of
11	Brookhaven Industrial Development Agency
12	public hearing for the American Organic
13	Energy, LLC project. It is 10:04 a.m. on
14	February 10, 2022. I'm going to read the
15	public hearing notice for the record.
16	NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a
17	supplemental public hearing pursuant to
18	Article 18-A of the New York State General
19	Municipal Law will be held by the Town of
20	Brookhaven Industrial Development Agency (the
21	"Agency") on the 10th day of February, 2022,
22	at 10:00 a.m. local time, at the Town of
23	Brookhaven Industrial Development Agency, 2nd
24	Floor, One Independence Hill, Farmingville,
25	New York 11738, in connection with the

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following matters:

3 American Organic Energy, LLC, a New York limited liability company, on behalf of 4 5 itself and/or the principals of American 6 Organic Energy, LLC and/or an entity formed or 7 to be formed on behalf of any of the foregoing 8 (collectively, the "Company"), has requested 9 the Agency's assistance in connection with the 10 acquisition of a leasehold interest in an 11 approximately 8.2 acre parcel of land that is 12 encompassed as part of a larger 62.00 acre parcel of land located at 445 Horseblock Road, 13 14 Yaphank, New York 11980 (the "Land"), and the 15 construction and equipping of an approximately 16 60,000 square foot building to be located 17 thereon including, without limitation, 18 pre-processing equipment, odor control, 19 anaerobic digestion tanks, by-product 20 processing, gas cleaning and compression 21 engines (the "Improvements" and "Equipment"; and, together with the Land, the "Facility"), 22 23 for lease by the Agency to the Company and 24 used by the Company in its business as an 25 anaerobic digester to process food waste,

oils, greases and grass clippings to be 2 3 converted to clean energy, clean water and soil products. The Facility will be initially 4 5 owned, operated and/or managed by the Company. 6 The Agency previously conducted a 7 public hearing with respect to the Facility on June 19, 2019. 8 9 Subsequent to the submission of the 10 Original Application by the Company to the 11 Agency, the Company notified the Agency of a 12 change in ownership structure of the Facility 13 and requested that the Agency consent to amend 14 the Application (the "Amendment to 15 Application"), to reflect that the Company 16 will be owned by AOE Holding, LLC a limited 17 liability company organized and existing under 18 the laws of the State of New York (the "AOE 19 Holding") to be the 100% owner of the Company. 20 AOE Holding will be owned by Charles 21 Vigliotti, Arnold Vigliotti, and Viridi Energy, LLC. 22 23 The Agency contemplates that it will

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24 provide financial assistance to the Company in 25 the form of exemptions from mortgage recording

taxes in connection with the financing or any subsequent refinancing or permanent financing of the Facility, exemptions from sales and use taxes in connection with the construction and equipping of the Facility, and abatement of real property taxes, all consistent with the policies of the Agency.

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9 A representative of the Agency will, at 10 the above-stated time and place, hear and 11 accept written comments from all persons with 12 views in favor of or opposed to either the 13 proposed financial assistance to the Company 14 or the location or nature of the Facility. 15 Prior to the hearing, all persons will have 16 the opportunity to review on the Agency's 17 website (https://brookhavenida.org/), the application for financial assistance filed by 18 19 the Company with the Agency and an analysis of 20 the costs and benefits of the proposed 21 Facility.

Due to COVID-19 protocols, all persons attending the Public Hearing will be required to wear face masks and maintain proper social distancing. Members of the public may also

1 attend the Public Hearing by video conference 2 3 by accessing the following link: us02web.zoom.us . . . it continues on, it's on 4 5 our website and entering passcode 177657. 6 Dated: January 31, 2022 7 TOWN OF BROOKHAVEN 8 INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPMENT AGENCY 9 By: Lisa MG Mulligan 10 Title: Chief Executive Officer 11 There is nobody who's come in to make 12 comment, but I did receive two email comments 13 that -- since there's only two, I'm going to 14 read them into the record, although if there 15 were more, I would not do this. 16 The first one says: 17 Dear Ms. Mulligan: 18 I write to express my opposition to the 19 proposed -- the project proposed by American 20 Organic Energy LLC and the IDA involvement 21 therein. Please include this written 22 statement in the record of the hearing today 23 as fully as if I had spoken in person or 24 virtually. 25 This proposal is another in the long

stream of spot projects approved in the Town 2 3 of Brookhaven without full review of the environmental impact, quality of life impact, 4 5 financial impact, and social/environmental 6 justice impact upon the residents of this 7 particular part of Brookhaven. The Town has 8 failed to adequately inform the community of 9 what, if any, overall plan is in place for 10 waste reduction and disposal and the means to 11 achieve that. It has not adequately received 12 community input into any decision-making 13 regarding these issues. And, it has failed to consider how the serial IDA decisions that 14 15 have granted real property tax exemptions 16 (i.e. PILOTs) affects all members of the 17 community -- of our community.

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For example PILOTs are taken into 18 19 account when New York State -- NYS Ed 20 determines the amount of state aid available 21 to the individual school districts, among other things. Has the IDA received a report 22 23 detailing this impact? There appears to be no 24 overall coordinated plan for how to plan for 25 our area and the IDA's failure to insist upon

2 a comprehensive plan prior to even considering 3 this current application makes it appear that the IDA has not done the due diligence 4 5 expected of your agency. Recognize that, by 6 granting approval of tax exemptions, you are 7 creating (perhaps, unintended) consequences 8 for other budgets and other tax-bearing 9 communities. I urge you to exercise the due 10 diligence required here and in all 11 applications coming before you. 12 Sincerely, 13 E. Anne Hayes I also received a comment from the 14 15 school district, give me one second. 16 (Pause.) 17 MS. MULLIGAN: I'm going to read that 18 one as well. 19 (Pause.) 20 MS. MULLIGAN: Okay. The second 21 comment that I received says: 22 Good afternoon Ms. Mulligan: 23 In regards to the Notice of Public 24 Hearing concerning American Organic Energy, 25 LLC Facility, having witnessed and experienced

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significant community interest and concern 2 3 over environmental issues, specifically related to the Brookhaven landfill, the 4 5 District respectfully requests that this 6 project go through appropriate reviews by 7 federal, state and local authorities, and in 8 that review, our community residents should be 9 included in the discussions, and have say in 10 the matter. 11 Thank you, 12 Dr. Joseph Giani 13 Superintendent of Schools South Country Central School District 14 15 We're going to leave this public hearing 16 open for about another 20 minutes.
