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Framerica Corporation, a business 4 5 corporation organized and existing under the 6 laws of the State of New York, on behalf of itself and/or the principals of Framerica 7 8 Corporation and/or an entity formed or to be 9 formed on behalf of any of the foregoing (the 10 "Company"), has applied to the Agency to enter 11 into a transaction in which the Agency will 12 assist the Company in (a) the acquisition of a leasehold interest in an approximately 84,156 13 14 square foot portion (the "Demised Premises") 15 of an approximately 230,000 square foot 16 building situated on an approximately 29.5 17 acre parcel of land located at 19 Nicholas 18 Drive, Suite 100, Yaphank, Town of Brookhaven, 19 New York (further identified as Tax Map No. 20 District 0200, Section 703.00, Block 01.00, 21 Lot 049.400) (the "Land"), currently owned by 1516-19 LLC, a Delaware limited liability 22 23 company (the "Landlord"), (b) the renovation 24 of the Demised Premises (the "Improvements"), 25 and (c) the acquisition and installation

accept written comments from all persons with 2 3 views in favor of or opposed to either the proposed financial assistance to the Company 4 5 or the location or nature of the Facility. 6 Prior to the hearing, all persons will have 7 the opportunity to review on the Agency's 8 website (https://brookhavenida.org/), the 9 application for financial assistance filed by 10 the Company with the Agency and an analysis of 11 the costs and benefits of the proposed 12 Facility.
